Dear Sir:

We are making a personal appeal to you as a stockholder of the Slate Aircraft Corporation.

Recently we, N. A. Gray, W. J. Cathcart, E. M. Kelly, T. N. Pritchard and A. M. Weger, had to start a suit and secure a restraining order against certain directors of the Slate Aircraft Corporation, and the Aviation Proving and Testing Company and others to prevent the sale of the assets of Slate Aircraft Corporation, including all our patents, to certain individuals who have formed the Aviation Proving and Testing Company. We as stockholders were advised by counsel that the proceedings for that sale were invalid. We also saw that if the proposed sale went through it would, in our opinion, mean a total loss to stockholders of Slate Aircraft Corporation. Something had to be done to stop it by someone, so we started the action for the benefit of all stockholders and have had to incur a heavy expense to save the situation. My financial condition and that of the other stockholders who brought the suit require that other stockholders help us financially. We ask nothing for our time and services but only assistance for court cost, attorneys fees and expenses. We are not asking much when we ask you to send us from \$2.00 to \$5.00 to help out. Do it by return mail. We are now working on new contracts with these folks which are to be submitted to you and the other stockholders for approval, but must have the money at once to keep things going.
